Recap: Great size and wingspan, intimidates due to her physical presence inside. Showed some good footwork and ability to finish with R or L around the rim. Lacks strength right now but shows toughness and attempts to play with power inside. Decent looking technique shooting from mid/long range, should take more shots. Has big time potential and solid offensively, good FT shooter, solid stroke, VERY LONG, runs floor well, lateral footwork not great. Fundamentally sound. Good attitude.
